## Important Library Information



Take a moment to learn about collection information and library policies

The library offers several resources to students including physical books, e-books and audio books, digital magazines, databases for research, and in library iPad usage.

Students can check out up to **5 books for a 30 day period**. During day school hours, students can check out books with the librarian. During evening hours students can use the self check out area which is located at the front of the library (near the windows). There is a check out form that should be completed for **each book** checked out. Students will need to include their **full name**, **their ID number**, **and the number on the back of the book under the bar code**. There is a sample photo on the check out form of the number that MUST be recorded.

Students can also checkout books using **Sora**, an online e-book, audio, and magazine platform. During the first month of school. All students will learn how to access *Sora*, during an English class library visit!
